



Advanced Retriever Workshop with Carol Cassity

When: May 28-29, 2011

Where: Addieville East Farm, 200 Pheasant Drive, Maplewood, RI

Time: seminar will begin promptly at 8:30am (breakfast at 8:00am)

What to Bring: chair, paper, pen and water for your dog if running

Limited Entries: There are a total of 12 working spots for SH and MH level dogs and 18 auditor spots (any level). Entry deadline is April 1st.

This is an advanced seminar for handler teams in the transition and advanced stages of training. This seminar will be suitable for both AKC and HRC training. Field setups will be supplemented with yard drills that will enhance handling and marking concepts run with participating dogs.

There will be setups covering a variety of training and handling challenges, for example: how to break down a triple for training purposes: identifying suction and factors, paying particular attention to the handlers role dealing with such. Carol will provide comments and suggestions on each run. All attendees are encouraged to ask questions throughout the seminar.

About Carol Cassity:

Carol Cassity is the author of Building A Retriever, Drills & More. Carol has been training her own dogs as an amateur since 1993. She has had experience working with a variety of pro trainers and breeds while working towards advanced titles in the hunt test game. Carol has worked with Chessies, Goldens, Labs, Tollers, Poodles, Boykins, Drahthaars, Curlies and Flat Coated Retrievers. She competes at both AKC and HRC hunt tests. Carol is an AA Finished judge in HRC. She has put multiple hunt test titles on her Chesapeake Bay Retrievers and Golden Retrievers, including: Grand Hunting Retriever Champion, Master Hunter, Hunting Retriever Champion and Upland Hunter. Carol's dog Tally was the first Chesapeake Bay retriever to achieve the titles of Grand Hunting Retriever Champion, 500 points and Master Hunter in the United States and the first of any breed in Florida.

Directions to Addieville East Farm

From Boston: Take Rte. 128 South to Rte. 95 South to Rte. 295 South to Exit 8B (Rte. 7 North). Go 6.2 miles and turn left onto Tarklin Rd. Go 2 miles to Addieville East Farm on the left.

From Providence: Take Rte. 146 North to the Rte. 116 South (Mall) Exit. Go to the fourth light and turn right on to Rte. 7 North. Go 5.3 miles and turn left onto Tarklin Rd. Go 2 miles to Addieville East Farm on the left.

From Worcester: Take Rte. 146 South to the North Smithfield RI Exit. Bear left off exit. Go to first light and turn right on Victory Hwy. (Rte. 102 South. Go to second light and turn left on Rte. 7 South. Follow Rte 7 South 1.3 miles and turn right onto Tarklin Rd. Go 2 miles to Addieville East Farm on the left.

From Hartford: Take Rt. 84 to Rt. 74 to Rt. 44 East to Chepachet, Rhode Island. Take a left (traffic light) at the intersection of Rt. 44 and Rt. 102. Bear right at the first fork (right beyond Citizens Bank) to stay on Rt. 102 North. Continue on Rt. 102 5.4 miles to the fourth light (third being at Middle School) and turn right on Rt. 7 South. Follow Rt. 7 South 1.3 miles and turn right on Tarklin Road. Take Tarklin Road (bear right over the bridge) 2 miles to the sign for our farm on the left.

From New York City: Take I-95 North to I-295 North (in Rhode Island) to exit 8B (Rt. 7 North). Go 6.2 miles and turn left onto Tarklin Road (bear right over the bridge). Go 2 miles to the sign for our farm on the left.
